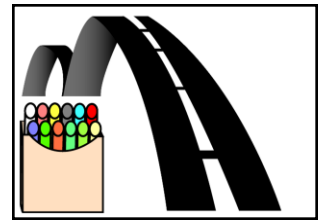


2017 Street Painting Festival Saturday, October 7 at 7 a.m.
