



Scout Expectations

We look forward to seeing you at Roane State Community College's Merit Badge College (MBC) on Saturday, February 17, 2024. To help make this event run as smoothly as possible, please read and follow these guidelines.

1. Obtain a copy of the Merit Badge pamphlet and familiarize yourself with the requirements. You are required to bring a statement certifying you have read the pamphlet but you should study it as well to get the most from your experience. Badges such as **Soil & Water Conservation** cover a tremendous amount of material and it is extremely difficult to pass all requirements if unprepared. In addition, failure to read the pamphlet may result in you not completing the badge; however, you should be thoroughly prepared no matter what badge you attend. Bring signed statement to the MBC and give to your MBC Counselor. It is the responsibility of each scout leader to verify that each scout has read their pamphlet. A copy of this statement (Reading Certification) can be printed off the Roane State MBC website.
2. Attendance alone will not guarantee a merit badge; only through preparation and participation will a merit badge be awarded. Research and prepare any reports or materials asked for in advance of the MBC. Requirements with time spans will not be handled by the MBC Counselor. If the requirements listed next to the badge are not completed, scout will earn a partial completion which may be finished at home by a local counselor.
3. Bring a notebook and writing instruments to the MBC.
4. **OUTSIDE BADGES** - Some badges will require some or all activities to be performed outside. Please note those badges and dress appropriately.
5. Badges taught off-campus will require a parent's signature on a "**Hold Harmless Release**" for Metalwork, Auto Maintenance, Crime Prevention & Climbing.
6. A second release "**Crime Prevention Parental Waiver**" is required for the Crime Prevention Badge to visit the Roane County jail facility. Both forms can be printed off the MBC website.
7. Come dressed in complete uniform. Uniform regulations of individual troops will be allowed.

Upon arrival at Roane State, follow signs to the gymnasium. Arrive early to allow time to locate the gym.
