Merit Badge College 2018 (MBC) is scheduled for Saturday, February 17, from 9 am- 4 pm on the Roane County Campus in Harriman, Tennessee. Enrollment is limited to 820 scouts.

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. The cost is \$15 for each scout and \$15 for each adult leader. One scout leader must be in attendance for every 10 scouts.

The registration fee includes lunch and the official Roane State Merit Badge College patch. Scouts must bring their own writing materials to take notes and **must** bring the official Merit Badge pamphlet for their badge.

Online Registration—3 Easy Steps

ALL registration is online. See website for “**Online Registration Guide**”.

Step 1: Now through October 31, from the Roane State MBC webpage, select the **Troop Registration** link (AKA *Register your Registrar*) and complete all requested troop information and submit.

Step 2: You will be emailed a web link to which you must respond to activate your troop's account. You cannot register scouts at this time. *If you completed Step 1 but did not receive an activation link in your email, call Tamsin Miller at 865.882.4640.*

Step 3: On November 2 at 9 a.m., the website will open at which time you may begin registering scouts **using the link you received on your second email** from completion of Step 2. Have your completed **Pre-Registration Worksheet** on hand.

Dates to Remember:

- Now through October 31 — Register your Registrar (AKA Troop Registration) begins
- November 2 (Thurs) — Open Registration for badges begins at 9 am EST
- December—invoices emailed/mailed.
- January 31, 2018 — Payment due. Reserved badges canceled.
- February 1 (Thurs) — last day to request refund & register.

Badge Requirements & Preparation

Scouts must:

- Bring a notebook and writing instruments to the MBC.
- Come dressed in complete uniform. Uniform regulations of individual troops will be allowed.
- Bring any required equipment such as compass (OR), thumb drive (PH) etc. (see page 2).

Attendance

Attendance alone will not guarantee a merit badge; only through preparation and participation will a merit badge be awarded.

Required Reading

1. Each scout is **required to READ, study & bring** to the MBC the appropriate merit badge pamphlet. Be familiar with the requirements.

2. A statement certifying you have read the pamphlet is required. See your scout leader for a copy of this statement or print one from the RSCC MBC website.
3. Research and prepare any reports or materials asked for in advance of the MBC.
4. Requirements with time spans will not be handled by the MBC counselor.
5. Requirements not covered at the MBC are to be finished at home by a local counselor.

Outside Badge Activities

Some badges require some or all activities to be performed outside. Note those badges and dress appropriately (i.e. climbing, forestry and orienteering).

Payment

Payments not postmarked by January 31 will remove your troop's reserved status.

Scouts will be dropped from pre-assigned badges, and the badges will be reopened for registered troops to select on Thursday, February 1. Online registration allows released badges to be claimed. Troops should check daily for newly released badges.

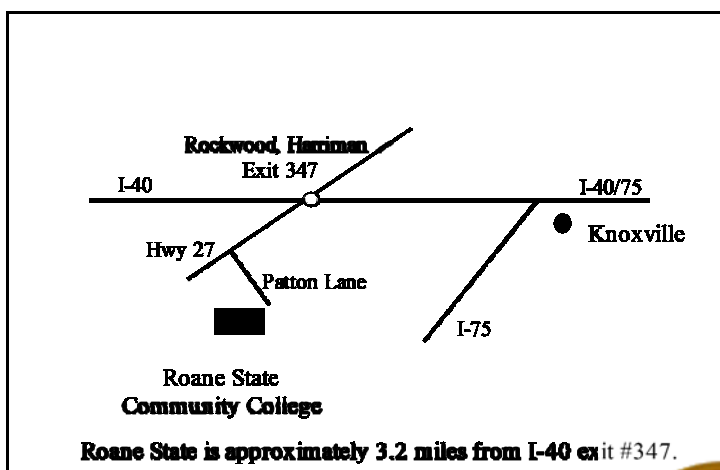
Should you still wish to attend after being dropped from reserved status, your scouts must select from available badges.

⊕ Age Restrictions

There are rank and age restrictions for these merit badges:

- ⊕ Citizenship in the Nation
- ⊕ Citizenship in the World
- ⊕ Environmental Science
- ⊕ Personal Management
- ⊕ Radio

To register for these badges, scouts must be at least in the eighth grade or 13 years of age, who have obtained the rank of Life or Star Scout, or who are in the process of completing their last required merit badges for the rank of Life or Star by February 17, 2018.

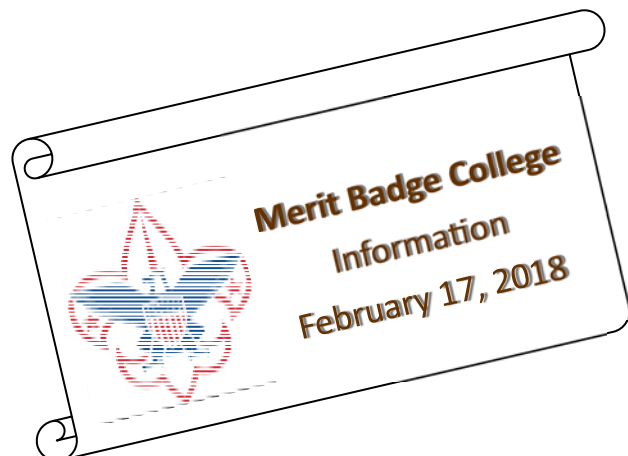
