What is mechatronics?

The mechatronics program trains students to become technicians who operate, maintain and repair high-tech automated manufacturing systems.

Think of mechatronics as a combination of engineering, computer programming, and robotics. If you enjoy technology and hands-on learning, then you will enjoy mechatronics.

Program highlights

- You can take the entire first year of mechatronics in high school through dual enrollment.
- You can complete the second year tuition-free at Roane State with the Tennessee Promise.
- Along the way, you will be prepared to earn Siemens Level 1 Mechatronics Assistant Certification and Siemens Level 2 Mechatronics Associate Certification, two credentials highly regarded by manufacturing employers.
- As part of the two-year program, paid internships are offered.
