

Speech Language Pathology Assistant Admission Information

- Step 1.** Submit your application to the college. After submitting your application to the college, you will receive a “R” number.
- Step 2.** Log into Raidernet using your “R” number to complete the Health Sciences Inventory form. Indicate your interest in being admitted to the **Speech Language Pathology Assistant degree program no later than May 15** of the year you are seeking admission. You may indicate your interest in 3 health science programs but you need to designate which program is first area of interest, second area of interest, etc. You will be considered first for the program you designated as your 1st area of interest. If you are not admitted to that program, you will be considered for the next area of interest unless the application deadline has passed.
- Step 3.** Declare **AS Pre-Allied Health** as your major. If you have not already declared AS Pre-Allied Health as your major, you should change your major. This will best prepare you for admission to a Health Science program.
- Step 4.** Meet **minimum eligibility requirements** to be considered for admission. Minimum requirements are as follows:
- Grade of C or higher in required general education/supporting courses
 - GPA of 2.5
 - Completed the below minimum 31-32 credit hours of required general education/supporting courses or currently have in progress by application deadline (all required courses with the exception of the humanities elective). Science courses must be no more than 5-years old by the application deadline.
 - SLPA 1310
 - ALHS 1211 or HIMT 1300
 - BIOL 2010 (must be completed within 8 years of beginning program)
 - BIOL 2020 (must be completed within 8 years of beginning program)
 - COMM 2025
 - EDUC 2210 or EDUC 2211
 - EDUC 2220 or PSYC 2210
 - ENGL 1010 (must be completed within 8 years of beginning program)
 - MATH 1530
 - PSYC 1030
- Step 5.** Students meeting minimum eligibility requirements will be ranked on the following 3 criteria (see below table):
- GPA in courses required for the major
 - # of required credits completed
 - Grade in required math/sciences courses and other required courses

Step 6. The top 12 candidates will be offered admission to the program. Applicants offered admission will be notified via an **“Alert”** in Raidernet and must accept or decline their admission within 1 week. After one week, the “Alert” will disappear. Failure to respond may result in the applicant forfeiting their selection for admission. **Applicants not offered admission will need to resubmit the area of interest form the following year.**
