You'll need to send in official transcripts from everywhere you've studied (even high school dual credit). If you have fewer than 24 college credit hours, send us your high school transcripts or GED.

If you have a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale, you're in. See, we told you it was easy.
