

Adult & Graduate Studies Undergraduate Semester Hour Requirements

To graduate from King University with a bachelor's degree, students must complete 124 semester hours of approved coursework.

- 48 semester hours King University residency requirement
- 76 semester hours combination of Common Experience / General Education requirements (outlined below) and elective credits

Common Experience / General Education Requirement¹

All students must have earned a minimum of 30 semester hours of general education and have at least one course in each of the following categories:

- Common Experience: Human Culture
 - Requirement met by completion of RELG 1001 at King University
- English Composition I & II
- Mathematics*
- Natural Science with laboratory
- Human Culture
 - Intermediate-level Foreign Language**, Old or New Testament, World Religions, Anthropology, or any course in Psychology or Sociology
- Human Creative Products
 - o Any course in Art, Music, Theater, Photography, or Appalachian Literature
- Humanities: History
- Humanities: Literature
- Citizenship
 - History, Political Science, or Government

Transfer Credit

King University accepts applicable qualifying transfer credit from regionally accredited colleges and universities.*** All transfer coursework is evaluated based on the educational quality of the coursework; the comparability of the nature, content, and level to King University coursework; and the appropriateness and applicability of the coursework to programs at King University.
