<sup>4</sup>Students should take a history sequence (i.e. HIST 2010 and HIST 2020 or HIST 2310 and HIST 2320).

<sup>5</sup>All applicants to the BSN program must have a cumulative GPA of a 2.75 or higher to be considered for admission.

-The following ratios are used for the curriculum plan: didactic hours to credit are 1:1 and clinical/lab clock hours to credit are 3:1. Therefore, there 615 didactic clock hours and 855 clinical/lab clock hours.

\*Students that graduate from RSCC with an AS in Pre-Nursing and follow this articulation plan will not be required to take any additional Math courses at LMU
