## President's Cabinet Meeting Minutes

- Guest: Sonya Parker oversees all of Roane State's non-credit offerings, with the
  exception of healthcare programs (which Kirk Harris coordinates). Sonya recommended
  that Roane State increase non-credit computer and mechatronics courses. Her biggest
  challenge is finding instructors. She told the Cabinet that Public Relations is helping her
  with a new marketing approach.
- 2. ATMAE Accreditation: Diane Ward reported that both the Mechatronics and Computer Information Technology (Programming and Cyberdefense) programs received accreditation from ATMAE.
- 3. SOAR 2022 Art and Partnership Awards: The deadline for submissions has been extended to November 19. Stacy Jacobs class is working on a project, and Teresa Duncan will work on a partnership submission.
- 4. Veteran's Wave: Keri Phillips is checking with Matt Waters to find out if we are able to livestream the event. Diane Ward will send an agenda to Dr. Goff this afternoon. Phi Theta Kappa and the athletes will assist during the event. The new Veteran's Coordinator will set up a welcome table. If rain is in the forecast, the event will be moved to the O'Brien Theatre.
