33% had experienced food insecurity in the past 30 days




43% had experienced housing insecurity in the past year

When it comes to higher education, Tennessee Promise and Tennessee Reconnect pay the last dollar tuition for eligible students – but they do not cover all expenses vital to student access and success. You have the power to bridge that gap by supporting the more than 500 scholarship opportunities for RSCC students made possible through Roane State Foundation each year.

- The Raider Fund is a growing endowment that supports a variety of scholarships for students of all counties, majors, and economic backgrounds across the RSCC district. Raider Fund scholarships are awarded based on both merit and need.
- Annual and endowed scholarships are funded by annual donations and/or investment earnings and make up the most significant number of scholarships awarded to RSCC students each year. Like Raider Fund scholarships, these are awarded based on both merit and need.
- The Pay-It-Forward program provides critical aid to students to eliminate barriers that could prevent them from moving forward with their education. Funds are distributed in three forms: Emergency Aid, Licensing/ Certification Exam Fees, and Finish Line Scholarships.
- <u>Dual enrollment scholarships</u> are awarded to high school students based on locally identified needs and recommendations.
- Middle College compresses the time it takes to complete a high school diploma and the first two years of college, enabling students to graduate high school and earn an associate degree at the same time.

Inspiring excellence at Roane State Foundation reaches beyond support for student scholarship programs. RSCC students who receive at least \$1,000 in scholarships (\$500/semester) at Roane State are more than twice as likely to graduate on time.*



Three of the ten counties in Roane State's service region are defined by the USDA as being in persistent poverty, meaning that 20% or more of the population has lived in poverty over the last 30 years.
